EYFS Cycle A	 I know why it is important to follow school rules. I know that it is ok to be different. I know that I live in a country called Britain. I know that we have a Royal Family and Kind Charles III is our King. I know how to keep myself safe in school.
EYFS Cycle B	 I know that there are consequences for not following school rules. I know how to be kind and treat people with respect. I know who to speak to if someone is unkind to me in school. I know what the British Flag looks like and its corresponding colours. I can manage my personal care needs independently.
Year 1/2 Cycle A	 I know how to make things fair. I know that people may think differently than I do. I know that people who live in Britain maybe the same as me or different. I know why rules are different in different places. I know that there are different types of families.
Year 1/2 Cycle B	 I know how and why we debate. I know what bullying means. I know that there are lots of different religions in Britain and that we respect everyone's right to worship. I know that there is criminal and civil law. I know that everyone has a right to be protected from harm.
Year 3/4 Cycle A	 I know how votes and the voting system works in Britain. I know that different people can be subjected to discrimination and why this is wrong. I know what it is like to live in Britain. I know what happens in a Magistrates Court and why this is important. I know that there are different types of relationships.
Year 3/4 Cycle B	 I know what a council is and what councillors do and why their roles are important. I know how I can stand up against all kinds of bullying. I know why I am proud to be British and why I am proud to live in Britain. I know what happens in a Crown Court and why this is important. I know that children across the world have a right to go to school.
Year 5/6 Cycle A	 I know what a Member of Parliament does and why their role is important. I know why the Supreme Court is important- (Link) Ten Commandments- You shall not steal. I know the consequences of bullying. RESPECT – Commando Joe's. I know why diversity is important and why homophobia is never ok. I know that everyone has a right to privacy- UN Rights of a Child- Article 16.
